Round 6 Adoption of Public Charging Infrastructure Request for Proposals

What is the objective of this Request for Proposals (RFP)?

To seek proposals for co-funding for public EV destination charging infrastructure to support and accelerate wider deployment and market uptake of electric vehicles as a key part of New Zealand's move to low emission transport.

This round's Investment Activity looks for Projects that will provide:

- 1. New or additional charging infrastructure to address queuing or provide access to fast charging using an innovative business model. The project needs to demonstrate a clear pathway for a scalable deployment of destination chargers.
- 2. Public destination chargers of between 25kW-50kW DC for community or neighbourhood charging, either standalone or as part of a network, where users will spend between 30 mins and 2 hours conducting other activities, for example at supermarkets and gyms.

Why apply?

This is an opportunity to actively contribute to the development and implementation of public charging infrastructure in New Zealand.

Who is eligible to apply to the Fund?

The Fund is open to all New Zealand-based and New Zealand-registered legal entities except Public Service Departments, Non-Public Service Departments (such as the New Zealand Defence Force), and Statutory Crown Entities such as District Health Boards.

When will other funding rounds such as for off-road, marine and aviation be opened? EECA intends to open funding rounds for marine and off-road, and will continue to offer co-funding for vehicles & technology projects and other charging projects. How can I apply?

You will need to submit a registration using the online RFP Response Form, available on the EECA website. Instructions and guidance for completing the form are in the online form, and you can also refer to a PDF of the Response Form.

The RFP document outlines the criteria for assessment.

When will the results be announced?

We anticipate informing applicants of their result from late March 2023.

Who decides which proposals will be funded?

An assessment panel will assess the proposals against a set of criteria and then make recommendations to EECA, which will make the final decisions on which proposals are shortlisted.
