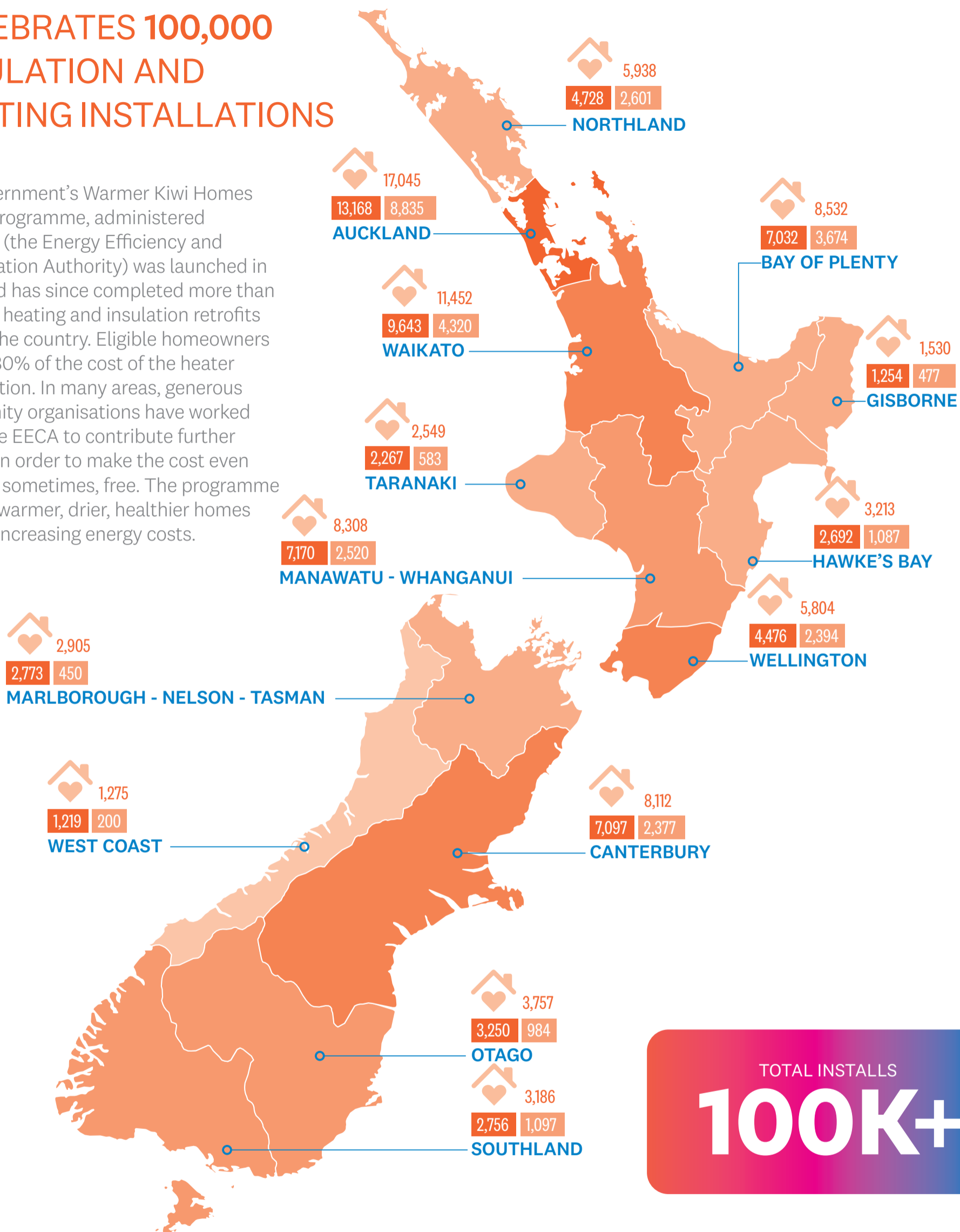


WARMER KIWI HOMES CELEBRATES 100,000 INSULATION AND HEATING INSTALLATIONS

The government's Warmer Kiwi Homes (WKH) programme, administered by EECA (the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Authority) was launched in 2018, and has since completed more than **100,000** heating and insulation retrofits around the country. Eligible homeowners receive 80% of the cost of the heater or insulation. In many areas, generous community organisations have worked alongside EECA to contribute further funding in order to make the cost even lower or, sometimes, free. The programme enables warmer, drier, healthier homes without increasing energy costs.
