

Testing results for 2019/2020: Fluorescent Lamps (CFL / LFL)



Each year EECA conducts laboratory testing to make sure manufacturers' and importers' products meet the requirements of the <u>Energy Efficiency (Energy Using Products) Regulations 2002</u>. Products are tested to check if they pass or fail Minimum Energy Performance Standards (MEPS) requirements.

This year, 4 models of compact fluorescent lamps and 9 models of linear fluorescent lamps were tested by a NATA accredited laboratory (as required by the Regulations). The testing results are presented in the table below.

Lamp Type	Tested	Failed	Passed
Compact fluorescent lamps	4	1*	3
Linear fluorescent lamps	9	0	9

^{*} NOTE: This model failed on *Colour Rendering* only (minimum energy efficiency requirements were met).
